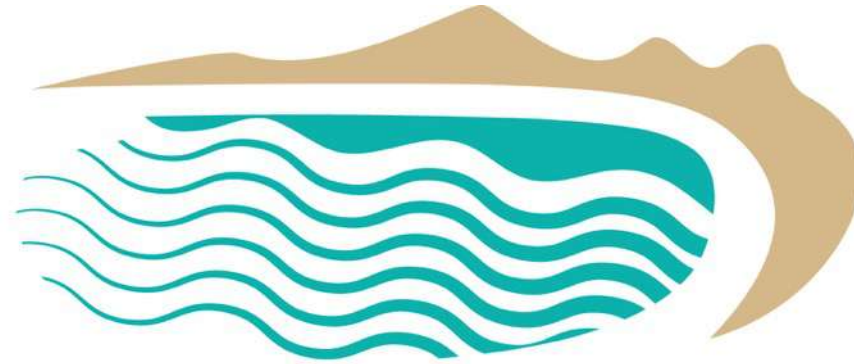

Welcome to Big Swamp



Big Swamp has a diverse range of bird life and native vegetation. A species list of birds is located inside of the bird hide. Rare flora that has been recorded at the swamp is Swamp Lobelia, Selliera and Echidna Sedge.

Along with the bird life there are other animals that are not often seen e.g. frogs, tortoises, carpet pythons and small lizards - all relying on the preservation of the swamp for their home. There are also many native grasses and sedges that assist the ecology of Big Swamp and provide habitat and food for the birds and smaller native animals.

Big Swamp is visited by overseas bird life and a number of migratory waders, such as the Red Necked Stint that fly from Russia to enjoy the summer months in these beautiful wetlands.

The Big Swamp Landcare Group would like to thank you for visiting this very special site and ask that you respect the native flora and fauna and leave the area in a clean and tidy manner.

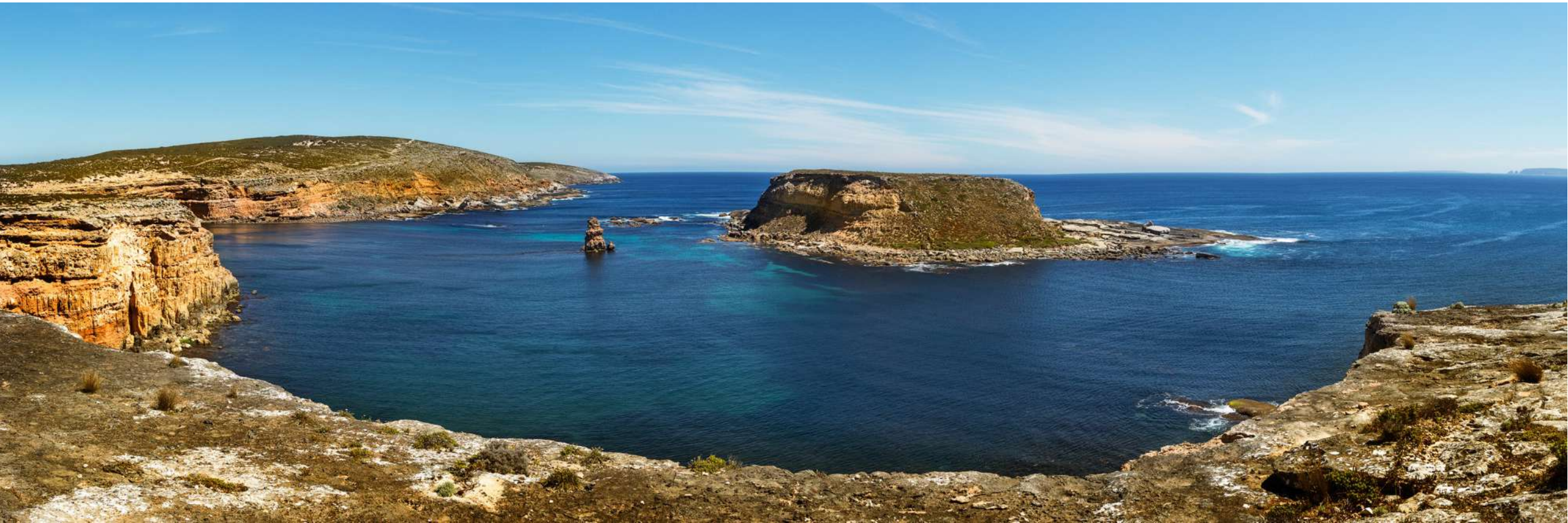

South Australia's Eyre Peninsula is Australia's ultimate temperate aquatic playground, featuring striking coastlines, vast sand dunes, rugged offshore islands, secluded coves and incredible marine encounters. The pristine waters are a sanctuary for some of Australia's most unique and curious marine creatures including dolphins, Giant Cuttlefish, Leafy Sea Dragons, and Southern Right Whales. The region has become renowned for offering opportunities to interact with these wild marine creatures, such as swimming with Australian Sea-ions, or cage-diving with Great White Sharks.

Within the region are several national parks protecting native fauna and flora. The rugged limestone cliffs of the Eyre Peninsula are a sanctuary for Chappie and White-bellied Sea Eagles and numerous other seabirds. Venturing further inland, the region is home to distinctive rock formations, and a variety of plants and animals, including Western Grey Kangaroos, Emu, Koalas, and Southern Hairy-nosed Wombats. The Southern Eyre Peninsula alone is home to 270 species of birds and around 1,900 native plant species within a variety of habitats.

Owner David Doudle is a fourth-generation farmer and has spent 30 years exploring the local area. He and his team's knowledge of the area and the longstanding relationships they have with the local communities, make touring across the region with Australian Coastal Safaris an unforgettable experience. 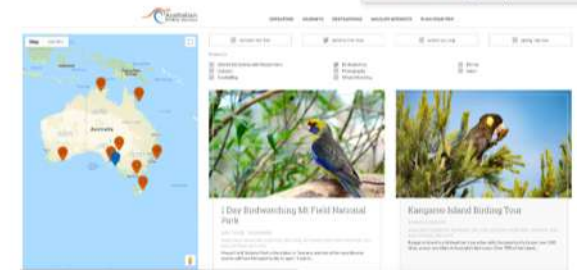


MAP SEARCH FEATURE LAUNCHED ON WEBSITE
